



Library Etiquette & Safety Precautions






Inside the library, I will whisper and keep my voice down.

I will walk in the library. I do not want to trip or hurt anyone if I run.










I must be careful when I am using library books or other library items.

Everyone can enjoy the books only if they are <u>not</u> damaged!




I must not climb on the bookshelves.


If I climb on the shelves, they may topple and books will fall off the shelves.

I do not want to hurt myself or others if I fall or when the books or shelves hit me.

When using the escalator, I must follow these safety measures:



I shall hold on to the handrail and stand still when going up or down using the escalator.



I will not run, jump or play on the escalator. I do not want to hurt myself or others. I shall not lean over the handrail too.



I must not stop or loiter at the landing area so that I do not obstruct other people.








There are potted plants




I can find a map like this near the library entrance.




Books

I can use the numbers to find the music scores I want to use.




I can explore PG and PG13 film-related audiovisual materials like DVDs and Blu-ray discs here.





The blue sticker indicates NC16 and M18 DVDs and Blu-ray discs.


I can explore NC16 and M18 filmrelated audiovisual materials like DVDs and Blu-ray discs here.




I will have to be 16 or 18 years old to borrow the NC16 or M18 audiovisual materials.




This is the Silent Studio.






I can look for this sign to find the toilets outside the library at Level 5.


This sign shows me the wheelchair accessible toilet.

Services



These machines are called **catalogue stations**.

I can find them all over the library.
I can use them to search for books I want to read.



This is a **book borrowing station**. I can borrow books using this station.



When borrowing DVDs, Blu-rays or music CDs, I need to insert the item into the left side of the **CD unlocker** to borrow it.

If successful, the audio-visual material will be unlocked.



This machine is called the **CD unlocker**. This can be found near the **borrowing station near the gantry.**


If I borrow audiovisual items using the NLB mobile app or the borrowing station near the lift, I must check that my audiovisual items are **unlocked** before I leave the library.



I can also borrow or reserve books and music scores using the **NLB Mobile app!**



I can scan this QR code to download the app using Google Play or Apple App Store.




I can also book the facility rooms such as **Piano Practice Room**, **Silent Studio** and **Screening Room**.




Log in to **NLB**

After I borrow a book, I can choose to print a receipt.


The receipt will look like this.
