I do not want to disturb other people.



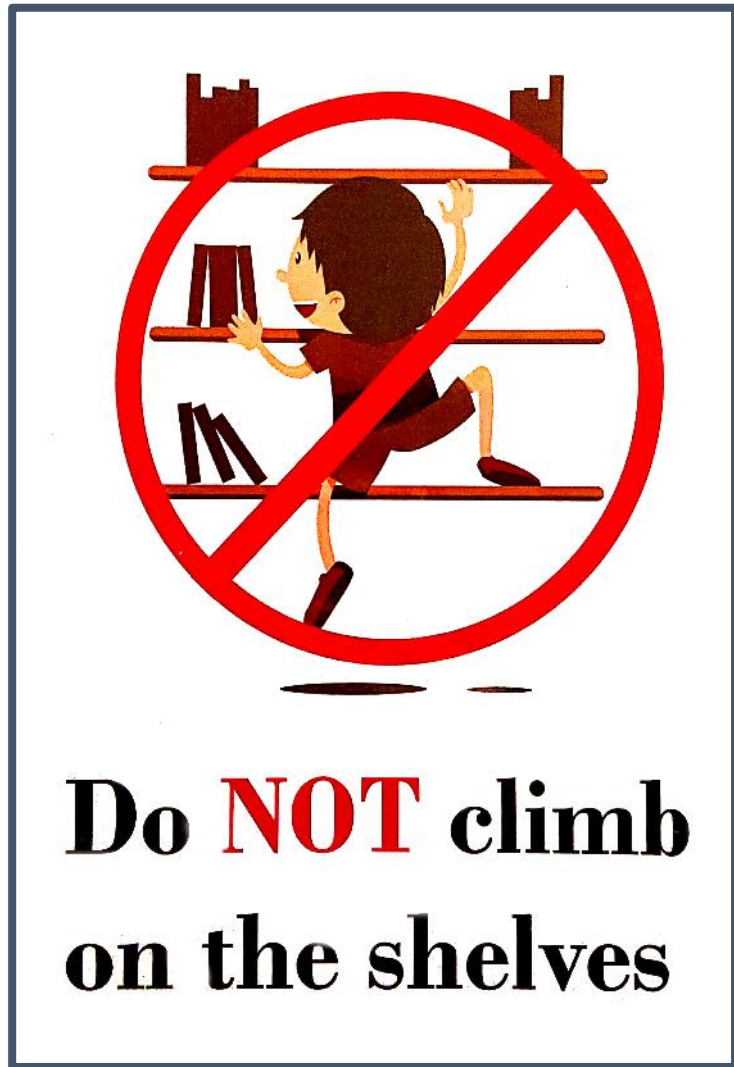
I will walk in the library.

I do not want my fingers to get caught between the drawers because it will be very painful.

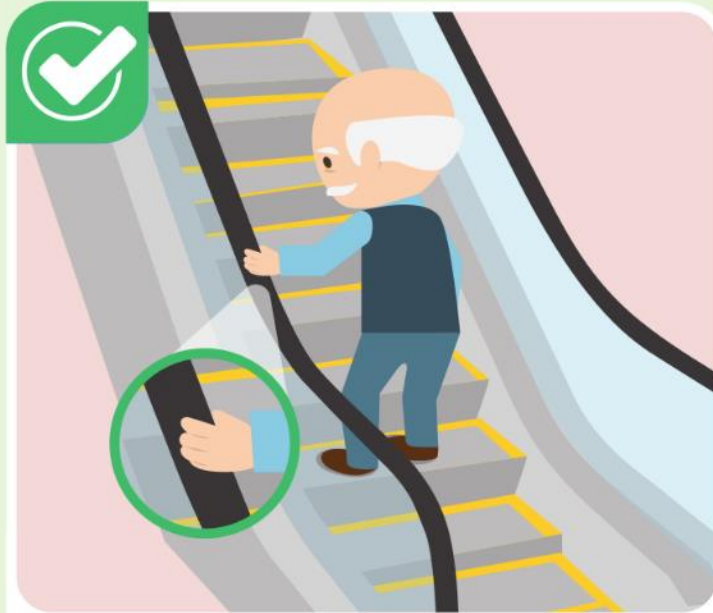


I must close the drawers fully.

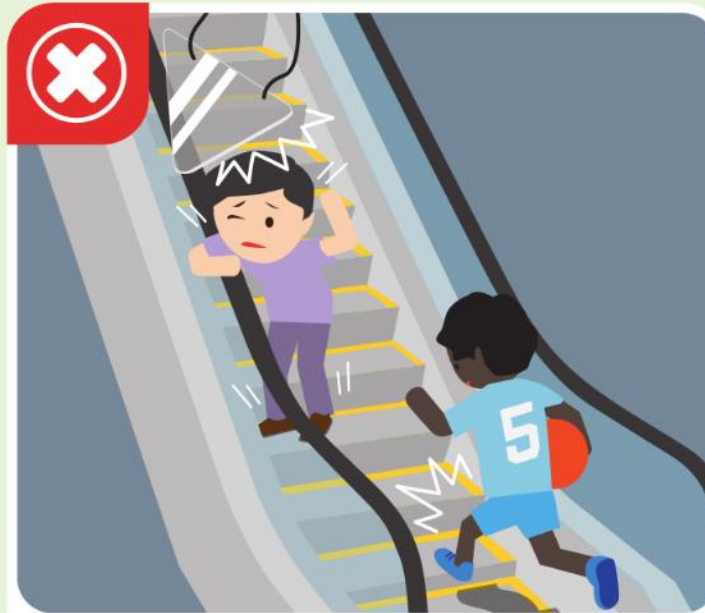
I will not leave any drawers open in case other people walk into or trip over them.

# When using the escalator, I must follow these safety measures:

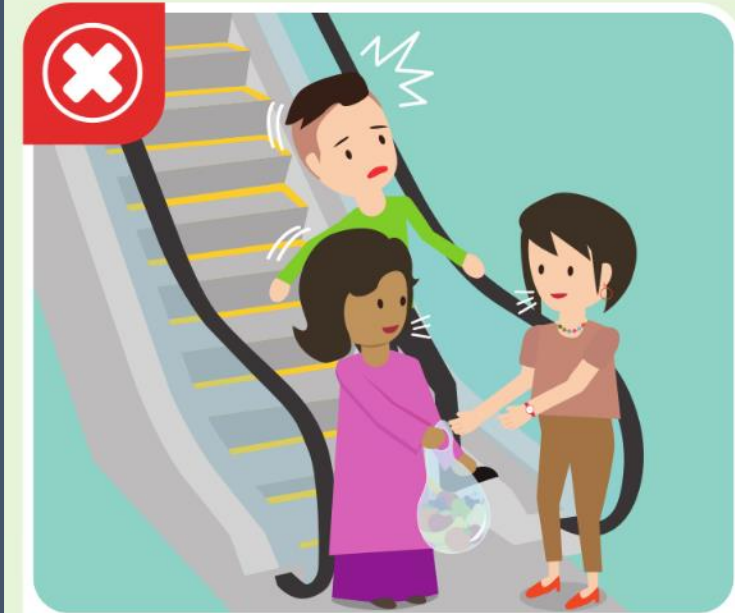

I can read and borrow new books.

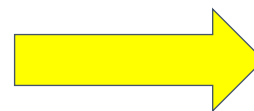




I can look for this sign to find the toilets at level 2.

on every level.





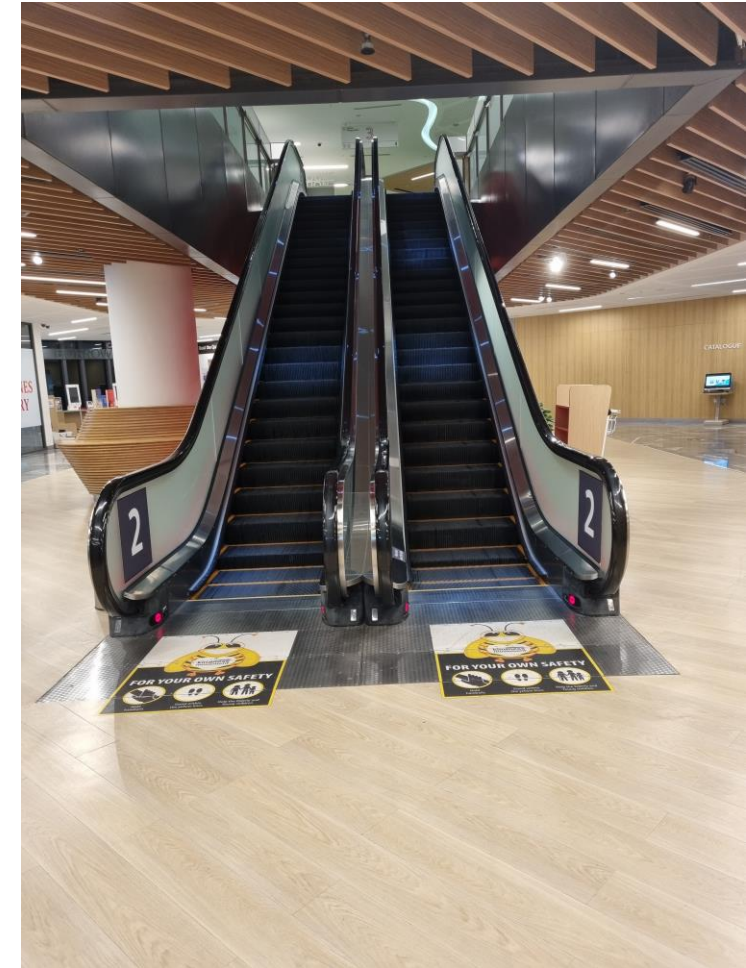
There are wheelchair accessible toilets on every level.

I can go to different levels by taking the lift or escalator.





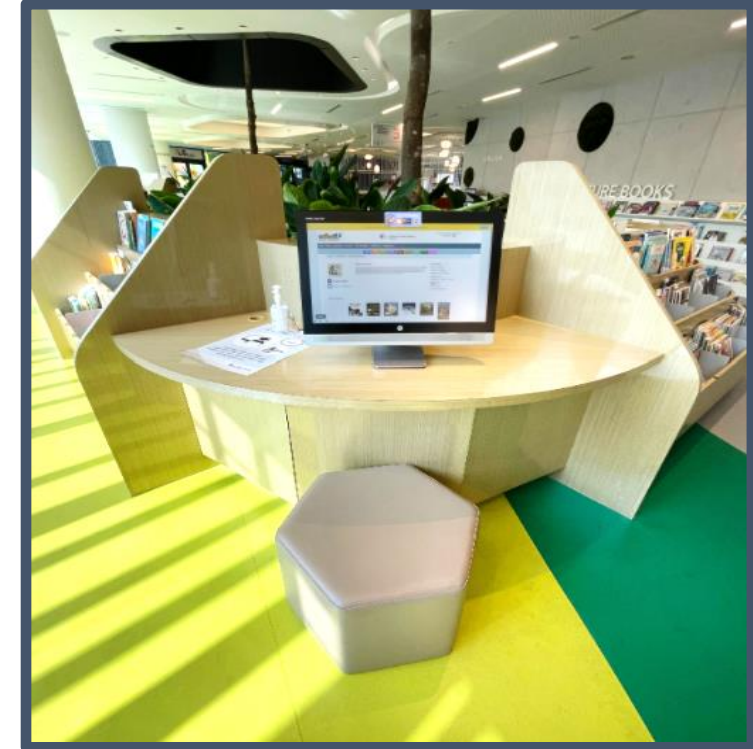
At level 3, I can find the children's section.

This is PLAYtopia, an indoor playground suitable for children up to the age of 7. I can ask my parents or guardians to book a paid slot so I can play here.



This is a TumbleBook station. I can watch and listen to talking picture books here.

At level 4, I can find the Teens section by the escalator. There are books suitable for those aged 13 and above.

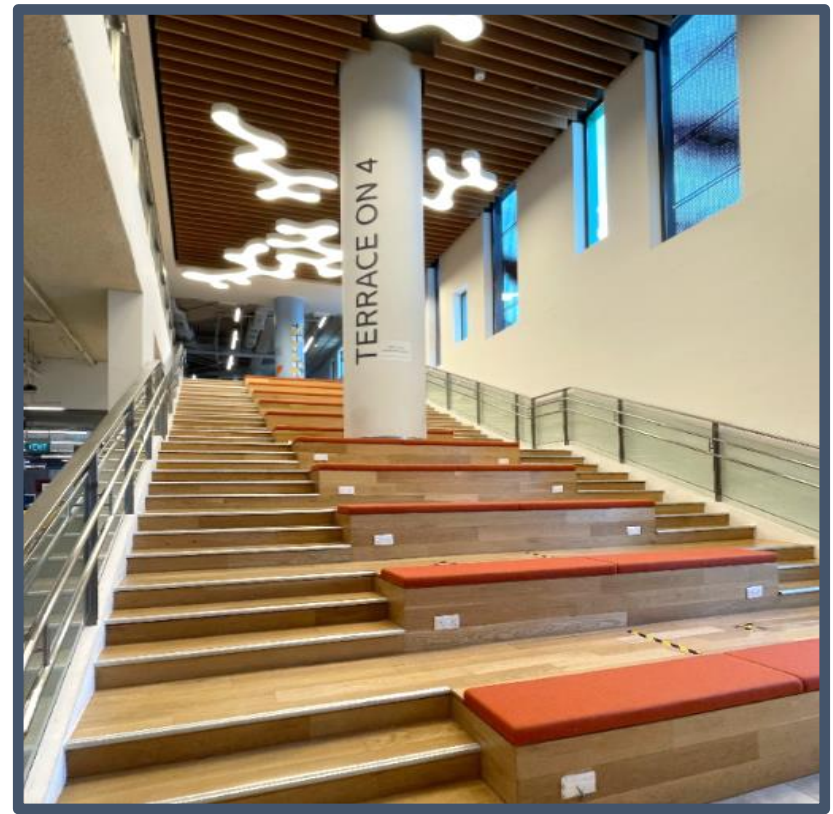
If I am at the lift lobby and walk down the corridor that is next to Terrace on 4, I can find books suitable for 7 to 12-year-olds.





This is MakeIT at level 4.

I can print 3D items and learn more about coding by booking a slot or joining the programmes.

On level 5, I can find and read non-fiction books for adults, including comics.

I can sit here quietly and do my homework.

I can attend programmes like storytelling sessions here.

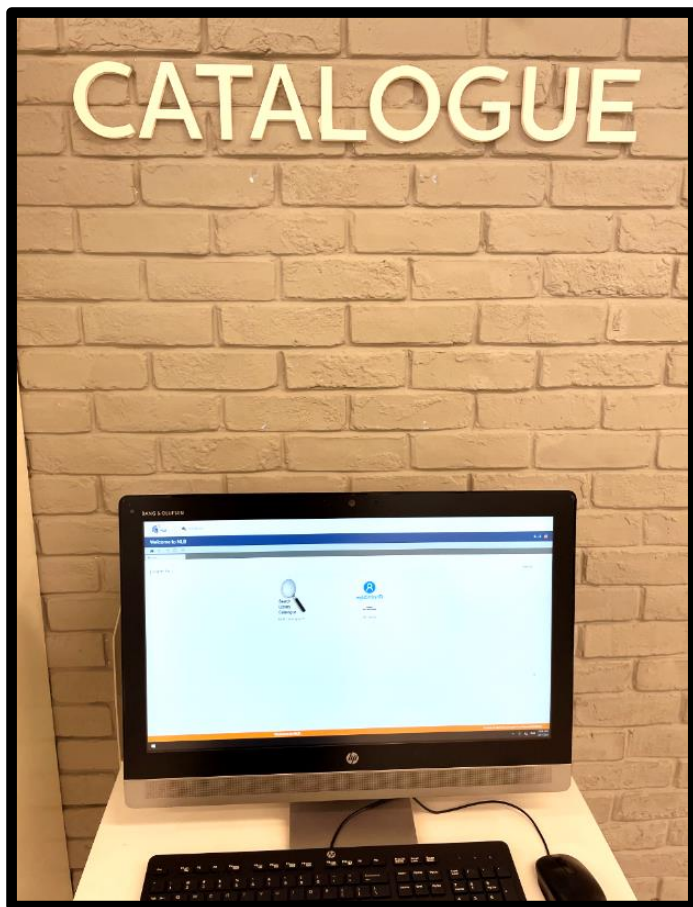


I can charge my mobile phone or tablet at this Quick Charge station.

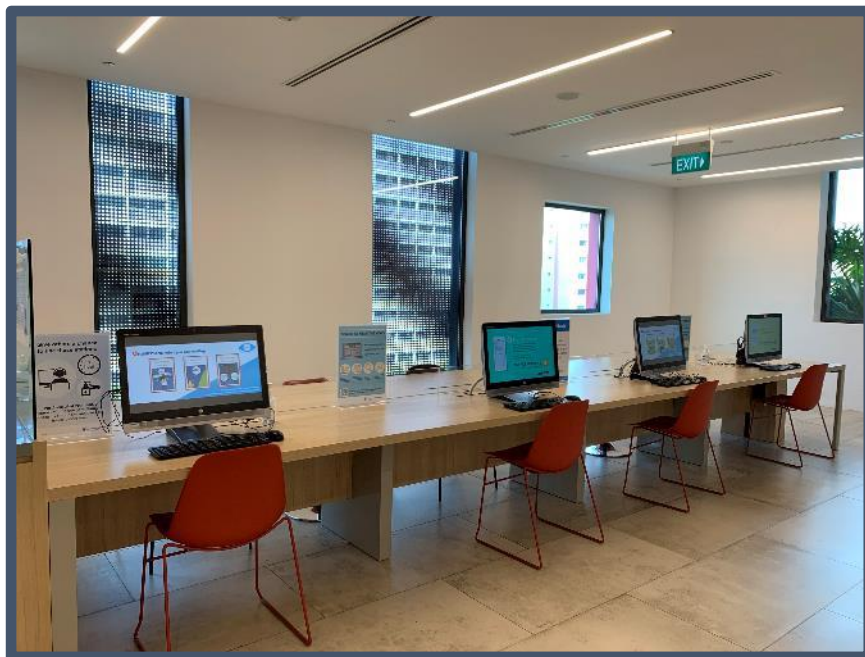


These machines are called

These computers are called Multimedia Stations.

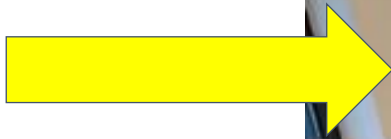
I can find them at levels 4 and 6.

Logging in with myLibrary username allows me to use the computers to do many things!

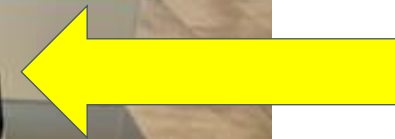
For example, I can read eNewspapers, eMagazines,

Before leaving, I can borrow them at these Borrowing Stations on level 2, using my NLB library card. I will queue until it is my turn to borrow books.

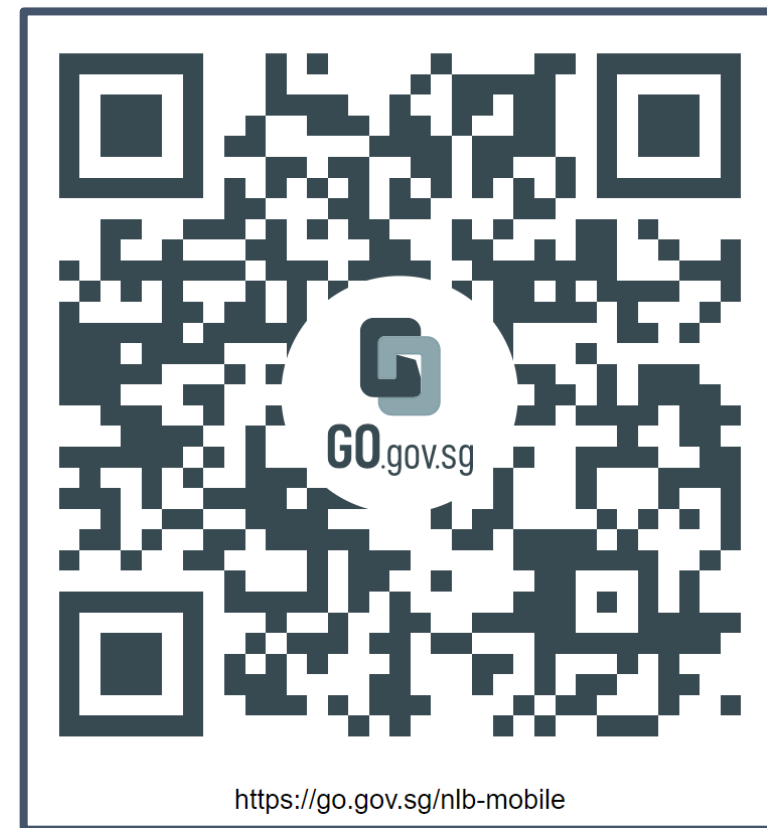

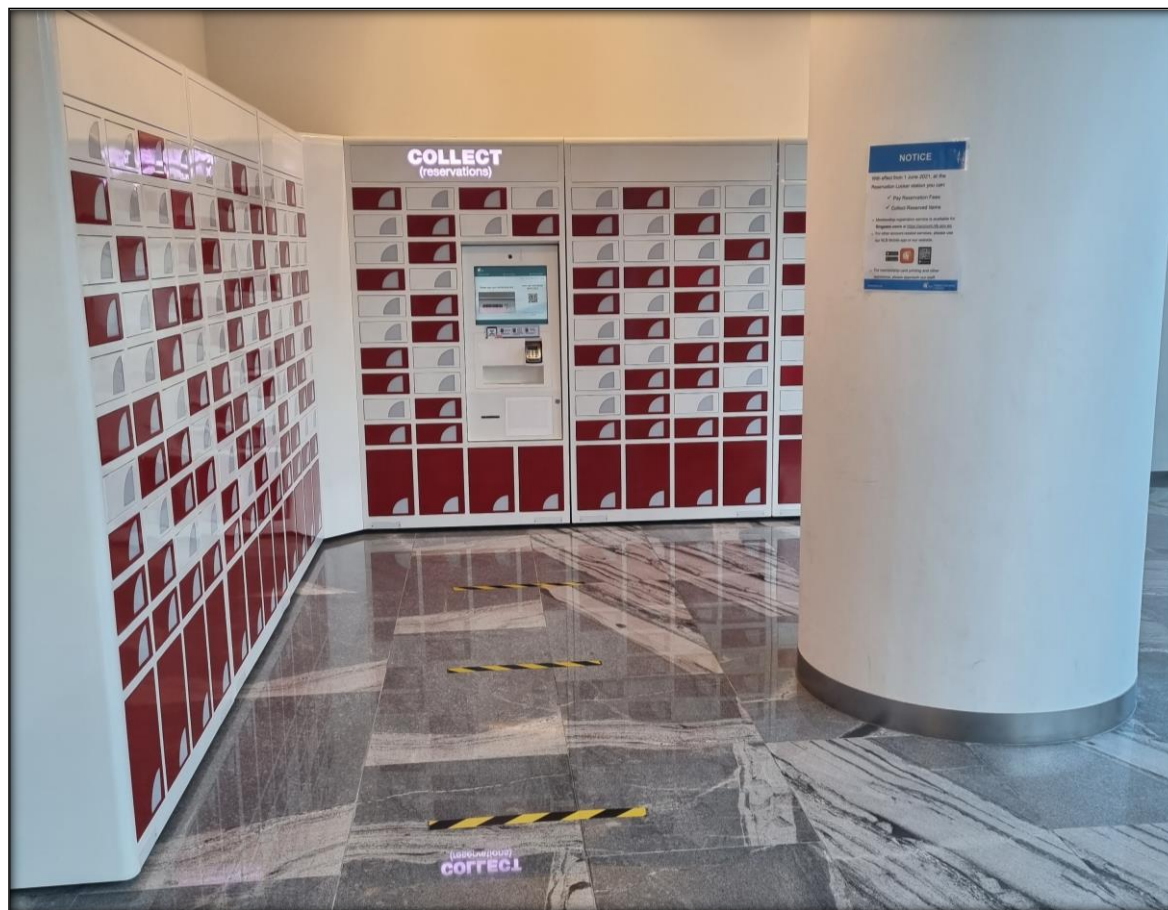
